Important notes:

- Students are required to login 15 minutes before the exam and be ready.
- Mic should be on during all times of the exam.
- The link of the exam will be posted at the beginning of the exam; students should open the link directly when it is posted, otherwise they will lose time from the exam.

Final Exam Important Instructions for students:

Before the Online Exam:

- Prepare yourself for the exam very well
- Make sure a proper space is allocated to take the exam without any distractions
- It is best to use a PC or a laptop to take the exam. Check your device to avoid last-minute problems.

During the Online Exam:

- Students should join 15 minutes before the exam time
- Mic should be on at all the time of the exam
- If you face any technical problems, please inform the teacher immediately, so they can support you. Please detail the problem, No Need to Panic.
- Check your work before you submit it. Ensure that every answer is complete and appears as you intended. Review the accuracy of your answers, as well as your spelling and grammar.

- Click submit 5 minutes before the end of the exam time. You should only do so once, but if you have a problem, try once more. If you still have a problem submitting the test, let the teacher know immediately.
